Creating environmental awareness among youth about conservation and protection of environment to build second generation environmental leaders.




Goal of Green Club:

Election Procedure for the Committee:

- Members has to nominate the potential candidates or candidates themselves can also do the nomination for each post. One person can be nominate only for one position
- The members can elect the nominated candidate for each position through secret ballot.



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- The candidate who gets the majority vote will be elected for the respective position.
- Both the election of Ad-Committee and Green Committee will follow this preceding procedure.

P.N.: Ad-hoc Committee will be valid for 2 months and Green Committee for 1 year.

Responsibility of Green Committee:

- Deciding the activities on different environmental issues and making action plan
- Maintain the discipline of the club and the members.
- Managing club monetary funds where will be 3 signatories, advising teacher, Green President and Green Treasurer.
- Ensuring the participation of the members in the events of ESDO.
- Communication and monthly reporting to ESDO about progress and activities of the club.
- Overall management of the Green Club.





Governance of Green Club:

- Two teachers will be advisor of the club for guidance and supervision.
- ESDO will be the facilitating organization.
- ESDO will provided the technical support, no monetary benefit will be given unless otherwise directed by the Executive Director of ESDO.
- The club will have full autonomy on its activities.

Procedure of Being the Member of Green Club:

The interested person has to fill-out the Green Club membership form and submit it to the convener/Green President with the 100 tk club fee. The yearly subscription fee will can be given in quarterly basis.

*All the collected fund will be managed by the Green Treasurer and the one of the advising teacher for the internal expenditure of the club.

Responsibility of the Green Club Members:

- Every Green Club member has to participate in the club meetings.
- Participate actively in the club activities.
- Involve in biodiversity protection, environment conservation and protection.
- Regularly fill up the monthly and yearly club fee.

Revoking the Membership of the club:

- Consecutively 6 month due of club fee or yearly fee.
- Consecutively absent in 3 club meeting.
- If not participated in the club activities
- Involved in any illegal activities.

Benefit of Green Club Members:


- Personal development and being skilled in organizational work.
