The project is implemented with five partner countries- Bangladesh, Spain, Turkey, India and Nepal. In Bangladesh ESDO is implementing the project.

ESDO Initiatives: Introducing the Green Club to Youths

In Bangladesh Environment and Social Development Organization-ESDO is implementing the Green Youth Citizens project. In the project one of the goals is to introduce a best practice in local community by involving the youth. ESDO has introduced Green Club as the best practice to bring change in the community. ESDO is working with children and youths since 1995 through different activities, such as forming clubs.
